CONDUCTED IN:

4 countries, 6 cities/towns, 29 research locations, 1062 households

Out of 3112 children under 18 living in families:



870 are street involved children



842 children never attended school

ALBANIA

Tirana

Out of total 103 interviewed families with 283 children living in families:



8% are living on less than one meal a day



1 of 3 families is without single pair of shoes

BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Bihać, Brčko

Out of 712 children living in families:



52,6% of children attend school on a daily basis

1 of 5



street involved children spend their entire day on the street

MONTENEGRO

Podgorica

Out of 150 families, 71 reported that their children were living and/or working on the street



59.2% children usually move around in the city or neighbourhood



21.1% move to other cities

SERBIA

Belgrade, Novi Sad

Out of 1744 children living in families, parents report that 629 children are street involved



55.5% spend 3 to 6 hours on the street



66,7% collect raw materials for recycling



10,3% play music/perform on the street
